

KEYNOTE SESSIONS – FRIDAY – JUNE 11

Opening Keynote Address *Surface: THE FINAL TOUCH*

Presented by: Ed McLaren, DDS, MDC CDT/RG: 1 hour of Scientific Credit • State of Florida: 1 hour of General Credit

his presentation will cover the final touches of contour, texture, surface colorants, and polish that can take an average looking porcelain, or monolithic glass ceramic and focus on the new generation glass ceramic, Zirconia Reinforced Lithium Silicate "Suprinity". Dr. McLaren will share techniques for monolithic Cubic Zirconia restoration and create an exceptionally esthetic result. These steps are critical to the success of dental restorations, especially now since more monolithic restorations are becoming the norm. This presentation will also cover the esthetics of the individual tooth. i.e. the individual form and color characteristics of teeth, introduce a new ZIRCONIA REINFORCED LITHIUM DISILICATE pressable material called "AMBRIA" and a new highly esthetic porcelain called "LUMIX".

Ed McLaren, DDS, MDC

Dr. McLaren is a Prosthodontist and Master Dental Ceramist. He is a retired Professor from both UCLA and UAB School of Dentistry. He is the founder and first director of the Post Graduate Esthetic Dentistry at the UCLA School of Dentistry and was the director of the UCLA Center for Esthetic Dentistry, a full time didactic and clinical program for graduate dentists. Dr. McLaren is also the founder and director of the UCLA / LACC Master Dental Ceramist program.

Dr. McLaren is currently the CEO of ArtOral America, a private teaching institute based in Park City, Utah. He maintains a private practice limited to prosthodontics

and esthetic dentistry in which he does all of his own ceramics. He is actively involved in many areas of prosthodontic and materials research and has authored or coauthored over 90 articles. Dr. McLaren is performing ongoing clinical research on various restorative systems. He has presented numerous lectures, hands-on clinics and postgraduate courses on ceramics and esthetics across the nation and internationally. He recently published a book on his ceramic techniques and features dental photographic art entitled, "The Art of Passion: Ceramics, Teeth, Faces, and Places."

Servicing Overdentures: Restore Retention, Reline Review, and More

This course will review the many problems the restorative team and their patients experience with overdentures. The speaker will discuss why these problems happen and the alternative solutions available; learn different techniques for attachment processing and relines; and discover how to select the proper overdenture attachment based on patient needs.

With the digital treatment approach, we are now able to plan the case with the patient's smile in mind. The utilization of smile design software in combination with implant planning software and a dynamic CAD-CAM system make the planning and design stage extremely predictable.

In the second part of this course, Wünsche will describe the importance of the correct material choice and what kind of zirconia (or even polymer) is appropriate for the specific case.
