GENERAL INFORMATION

COVID HEALTH & SAFETY INFORMATION

FDLA and the Renaissance Orlando at SeaWorld have put together a great safety plan for the 2021 Southern States Symposium & Expo. CDT/REG & FLORIDA BOARD OF DENTISTRY CREDITS

- **Continuing Education requirements for Florida Dental Labs can be found on page 7 of this program.**



- Please note FDLA will be using name badge scanners to track CE credits instead of utilizing bubble sheets for technicians and verification forms for dentists. Scanners will be located outside of every course room. **You will need to scan your name badge as you enter and exit each course room to receive credits.** This information will be submitted directly to NBC and CE Broker for credit reporting.
- **In order to comply with NBC policies, all attendees MUST be in the classroom within 15 minutes of the course start time in order to receive credit for the course. Anyone entering the classroom beyond 15 minutes after the start time will NOT receive credit for the course, and no exceptions will be made.**
- If you submitted your CDT/REG number on your registration form, this number will be printed directly on the front of your name badge. This is simply for back-up if any issues arise with the name badge scanners.
- FDLA hosts will provide you with a receipt of attendance for each course you attend to keep for your personal records. In order to comply with NBC policies, FDLA hosts are not allowed to distribute receipts of attendance until the end of each course.

CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS FOR FLORIDA DENTAL LABS

Effective January 31, 2018, the Department of Health will accept proof of certification by the National Board for Certification in Dental Laboratory Technology to satisfy your continuing education requirements of Rule 64B27-1.003, F.A.C.

64B27-1.003 Continuing Education Requirements. (6) Owners or designated employees that are certified by the National Board for Certification in Dental Laboratory Technology as a Dental Laboratory Technician during the biennium can demonstrate compliance with the continuing education requirements of this rule by entering his or her Certified Dental Technician certification number and submitting a copy of his or her active certification card in the CE tracking system.

What You Need To Know To Be In Compliance

IF YOUR DESIGNEE IS A CDT

*Effective January 31, 2018 – CDT's in good standing can upload a copy of their CDT card to CE Broker and waive all other requirements (FL Laws & Rules, Prevention of Medical Errors and General Credits).

IF YOUR DESIGNEE IS NOT A CDT

Your laboratory will need 18 hours every two years:

- 1 Hour – FL Laws and Rules of Dental Laboratories and Dental Technicians
- 2 Hours – Prevention of Medical Errors (on either OSHA or FDA)
- 15 Hours – General (any combination)

Who is responsible for attaining all 18 hours of Continuing Education?

Each Florida dental laboratory for their February 2022 state registration renewal must prove that a person employed by the laboratory for one full year at full time status has acquired 18 hours of continuing education credit approved by the Florida Board of Dentistry. Florida requires every business that is registered as a dental laboratory with the Florida Department of Health to document that the owner of the laboratory, or a dental technician who is employed full time by the laboratory, maintains 18 hours of approved continuing education in dental technology every two years.

Can laboratories split up the total continuing education hours between employees?

Laboratories may not split the required continuing education credit between employees.

Where can I get my credits and how do I know if the courses I attend will be accepted by the State of Florida?

The designated laboratory employee may obtain continuing education credits through online offerings, home study or in person courses. It is the responsibility of the laboratory to ensure a course is approved for Florida credits.

What is the timeframe in which I must attain all 18 hours?

All of the 18 hours that will be required with the February 2022 registration renewal must have been collected between March 2020 and February 2022. Credits earned before March 2020 will NOT be counted towards the required 18 hours of continuing education required in February 2022.

Sworn Affidavit and Certificates of Attendance

Florida laboratories will be required to submit a sworn affidavit with their February 2022 registration renewal listing the date, location, sponsor, subject matter and hours of completed continuing education for the designated employee. The laboratory will also be required to keep backup receipts, certificates of completion or vouchers for the submitted courses in case the state requests the information. The state may request this backup information at any time, or may select laboratories at random to audit.

Florida Board of Dentistry

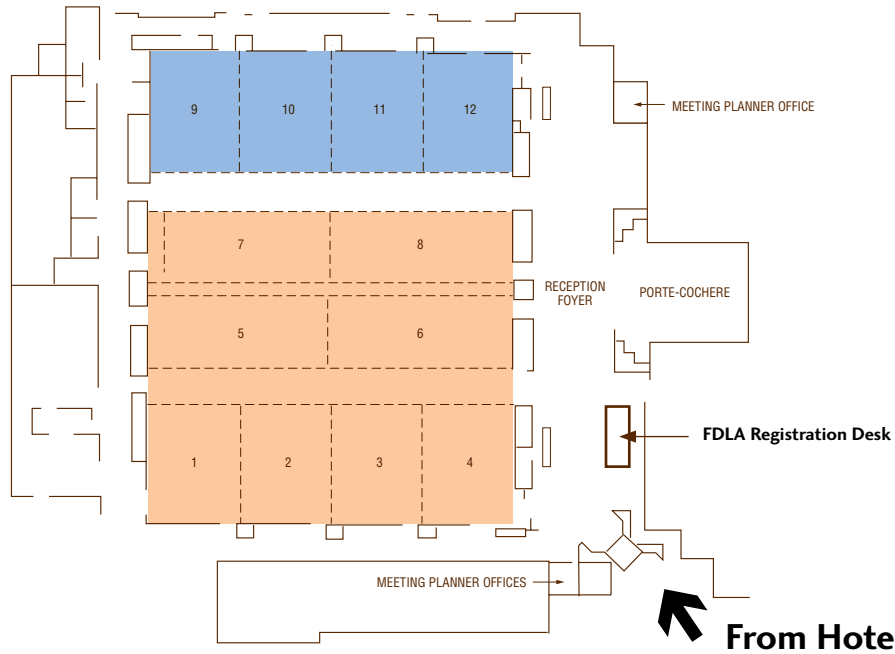
The Florida Dental Laboratory Association and the Florida Dental Association are automatically accepted as approved providers of acceptable continuing education credits by the Florida Board of Dentistry.

- Suppliers, schools or other entities may be approved by the Florida Board of Dentistry to provide credits, after completing an application, which can currently be found on www.cebroke.com. You may find a list of courses approved by the Florida Board of Dentistry at www.cebroke.com. Online courses and courses outside the state of Florida are eligible for approval.

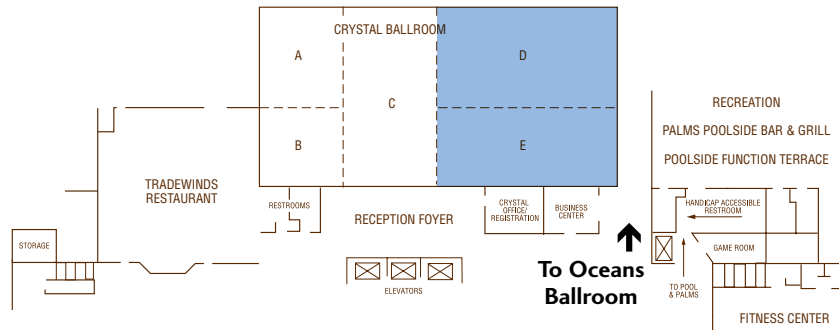

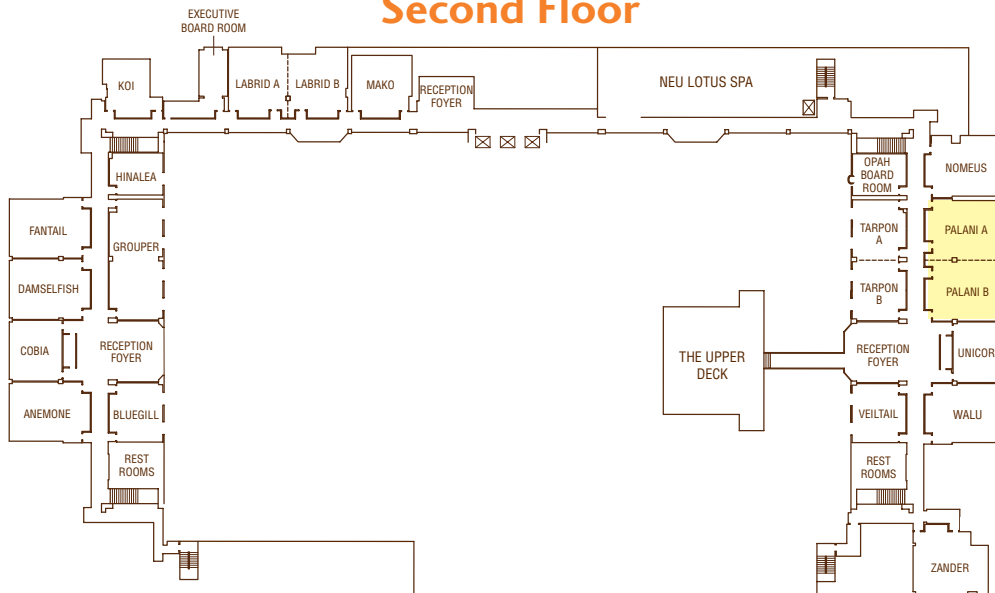

Opening Keynote Address

Surface: THE FINAL TOUCH

Presented by: Ed McLaren, DDS, MDC

This presentation will cover the final touches of contour, texture, surface colorants, and polish that can take an average looking porcelain, or monolithic glass ceramic and focus on the new generation glass ceramic, Zirconia Reinforced Lithium Silicate “Suprinity”. Dr. McLaren will share techniques for monolithic Cubic Zirconia restoration and create an exceptionally esthetic result. These steps are critical to the success of dental restorations, especially now since more monolithic restorations are becoming the norm. This presentation will also cover the esthetics of the individual tooth, i.e. the individual form and color characteristics of teeth, introduce a new ZIRCONIA REINFORCED LITHIUM DISILICATE pressable material called AMBRIA and a new highly esthetic porcelain called LUMEX® AC.

Ed McLaren, DDS, MDC

Dr. McLaren is a Prosthodontist and Master Dental Ceramist. He is a retired Professor from both UCLA and UAB School of Dentistry. He is the founder and first director of the Post Graduate Esthetic Dentistry at the UCLA School of Dentistry and was the director of the UCLA Center for Esthetic Dentistry, a full time didactic and clinical program for graduate dentists. Dr. McLaren is also the founder and director of the UCLA / LACC Master Dental Ceramist program.

Dr. McLaren is currently the CEO of ArtOral America, a private teaching institute based in Park City, Utah. He maintains a private practice limited to prosthodontics and esthetic dentistry in which he does all of his own ceramics. He is actively involved in many areas of prosthodontic and materials research and has authored or co-authored over 90 articles. Dr. McLaren is performing ongoing clinical research on various restorative systems. He has presented numerous lectures, hands-on clinics and postgraduate courses on ceramics and esthetics across the nation and internationally. He recently published a book on his ceramic techniques and features dental photographic art entitled, “The Art of Passion: Ceramics, Teeth, Faces, and Places.”
