It's tough to compete if you don't understand the landscape. In this session, Braswell will share the trends impacting today's practicing dentists. Most labs are feeling the squeeze. She will dive into the opportunities which exist for the laboratories that develop market strategies to meet them head on.

Braswell has spent the bulk of her career as an executive leading not-for-profit dental organization. For ten years, she served as the Co-Executive Director for the National Association of Dental Laboratories and the National Board for Certification in Dental Laboratory Technology (2001 – 2011). During that time, she launched The Foundation for Dental Laboratory Technology to promote and provide educational resources and scholarships for dental technicians and she became a passionate advocate for dental technicians and the critical role they play within the dental profession.

In 2011, Ricki became the President and CEO of The Pankey Institute. During her 8 years of service with Pankey, she grew the organization by focusing on the highest quality dental education and developing collaborative relationships, which resulted in a 100% growth in the organization's revenue and the expansion of the educational offering. She spearheaded a multimillion-dollar renovation to The Pankey Institute, which included installing a full digital workflow so that dental professionals could have the most cutting-edge technology available to them as they learn.

In 2019, Ricki launched Beyond Coaching, an executive and business coaching firm. She works with high performing dentists and their teams, dental labs, non-profits and entrepreneur CEOs.

Braswell is passionate about dentistry, helping other professionals grow and being a positive role model. She is often invited to present and she is known for her ability to share practical, applicable wisdom as she inspires.

Dr. Garine graduated from Cairo University School of Dentistry in Egypt in 1995. After moving to Canada, he joined the Dental School at the University of Western Ontario, where he earned his dental degree (DDS) and received the Dr. Gerald Z. Wright Award for excellence. He then joined the Eastman Dental Center at University of Rochester, in NY where he spent three years specializing in Prosthodontics. Dr. Garine spent the following year teaching at the University of Rochester and completed the Implant Fellowship, for which, he received the Dr. Gerald N. Graser Fellowship Award.

Dr. Garine is the Director of the Seaside Study Club (local chapter of the Seattle Study Club in Jupiter, FL), and a clinical assistant professor at the University of Rochester, Rochester NY. He maintains private practices in Jupiter and West Palm Beach, FL limited to Prosthodontics and implant dentistry.

Most dental labs now receive and transmit Protected Health Information (PHI) electronically with their dental clients and partners. This may be through emails, text messaging, chat applications, and case management portals. The Office of Civil Rights has the authority to audit covered entities to ensure that the business is fulfilling the regulatory requirements.
